CHILDREN'S CHURCH:

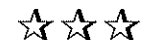
Children ages 2-5 are dismissed during the offertory for Children's Church, which meets in rooms 116 and 117 on the first floor of the Christian Education Building.

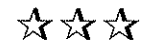
NO SUNDAY EVENING OR WEDNESDAY EVENING ACTIVITIES THIS WEEK.

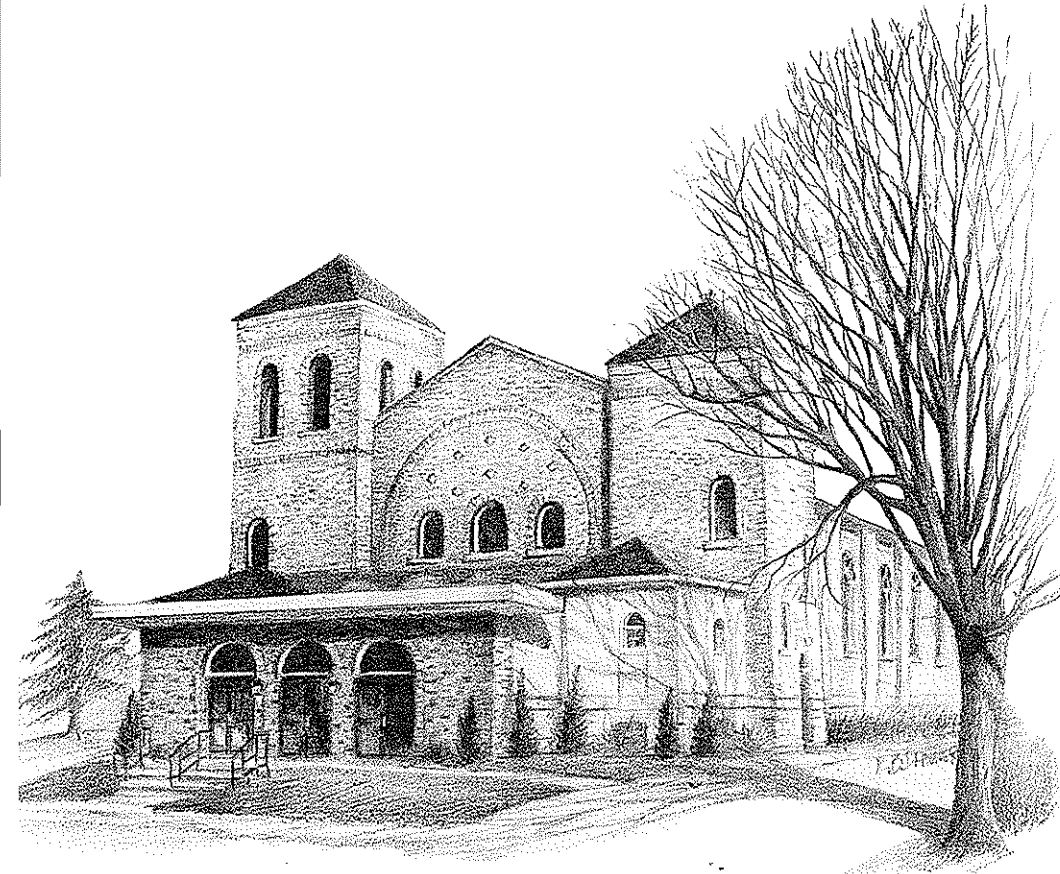
