

In the 2018-19 HWC Community Financial Plan 18 percent was budgeted for Physical Plant. That portion is managed by the Trustees which are elected by the congregation. Funds from that budget enabled several projects to be completed this summer that improve our facility:

- A new light fixture for the parking lot was purchased and installed.
- New carpeting in the 5th grade Sunday school room was installed and looks great.
- Railings at the side entrances have been put up and improve safety on those steps.
